Mental Health & Addiction Support

One in five Canadians experienced mental illness before the pandemic. Today, it's one in four. Opioid overdoses are at an all-time high and tragically, so are drug-related deaths.

Family Support

One in three preschoolers in Manitoba live in poverty--the highest rate of any Canadian province. More Winnipeg families

are relying on food banks and struggling to provide adequate shelter and clothing. Indigenous and newcomer families have been hit hard financially by the pandemic, making culturally relevant supports even more crucial. **Every Winnipegger deserves good health and well-being.** You can help eliminate barriers to mental health and addiction services, so no Winnipegger has to struggle alone.
