

Each of these companies set its own workplace campaign target and planned a wide range of engaging activities to ensure United Way Winnipeg's 2019 campaign exceeded its goal. "As a Winnipeg-based company, it's not a choice to help others in our community, it's an obligation," said Darryl Levy, President and CEO of Wynward Insurance Group.

Levy said Wynward's 104 team members recognize the value and importance of solidifying around a campaign and being engaged, as evidenced by their 100% United Way campaign pledge participation in all of their offices across Canada, as well as their interest in experiencing first-hand the profound impact that agencies have in our community.

For one of many campaign events, Levy chartered a bus, they closed up shop, and every team member at Wynward went on an agency visit to Graffiti Art Gallery. In previous years they have done the same, visiting other donor-supported United Way Winnipeg agencies.

Team members at Richardson International also participated in bus tours to various agencies and, for the first time, attended a Lunch and Learn, where a speaker from United Way Winnipeg's Speakers Bureau spoke about the value of the United Way Winnipeg network of agencies, said Robert Young, Employee Campaign Chair for Richardson International.

Richardson International also exceeded its campaign goal, with a campaign total of over \$350,000, which was then matched by JRSL.

"We saw 100 Leadership-level donors for the first time and signed up 58 donors who hadn't contributed through Richardson previously," said Young.

It's a united effort that consistently yields outstanding results for our community.

Living on the Edge ASSINIBOINE CREDIT UNION (ACU)

While many Winnipeggers feel compassion for those living in poverty, it's hard to imagine how it would feel to actually experience it.

ACU wanted to give staff the opportunity to learn more about living in poverty and put their company's values into action.

"Our credit union is committed to providing access to those who experience barriers to financial services," said Employee Campaign Chair Aaron Russin, Continuous Improvement Analyst, ACU. "Living on the Edge is a way to connect to the experience of Manitobans we serve who are living or have lived in poverty, to gain more insight, understanding, and compassion for the contributing factors of their situation."

Living on the Edge: Taking a Look at Poverty is a unique, two- to three-hour interactive group experience organized by United Way Winnipeg that gives participants a glimpse into poverty. The simulation also shows how overwhelming and difficult it can be to pull oneself out of poverty without support.

Kalyn Maskiw-Connelly, Grants and Sponsorship Program Coordinator, was one of ACU's many staff members to participate in the Living on the Edge poverty simulation.

"It's hard to develop empathy when you don't understand the situation," said Kalyn. "By immersing yourself in the experience, it really engages you and puts you in a position to better understand the complexity of Manitoba's social systems, and the emotional struggle of navigating them and trying to make it through a week. It's an effective tool for building empathy."

Kalyn said her experience made her truly appreciate the value of community.

"Thankfully there are asset building programs and other programs and services through United Way Winnipeg's network of agency partners that can empower people who are experiencing poverty," she said. "But these programs can only do this important work with the support of the community – with the support of us."

2019 was Skip's first year partnering with United Way Winnipeg, and they were committed to making a big impact.

"We wanted to partner with an organization where we could make the most out of community action," said Shanae Blaquiere, SkipTheDishes. "Short-term fundraisers are good, but we wanted the opportunity to engage beyond that and build a long-term relationship where there was room for innovation and where we could use team members' talents in exciting and creative ways."

Whether you're working in business or labour, the public, private or nonprofit sector, one thing is certain: when we work together, we're stronger together.

It's a belief that has served Motor Coach Industries Ltd. extremely well over the years, thanks to strong ties with their Union, the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, Local Lodge 1953 (IAMAW-1953).

The Union played a key role in supporting Motor Coach's workplace campaign with United Way Winnipeg.

Patrick Dram from IAMAW-1953 helped bring together people in different areas on the shop floor to be ambassadors for United Way Winnipeg and raise awareness and generate enthusiasm. "I wanted to see as many people as possible be engaged and know what United Way Winnipeg does in the community," said Dram.

The Union also made a donation to Motor Coach's workplace campaign.

"Their support and collaborating and being seen as partners are very important to us," said Denis Sutton, HR Liaison with Motor Coach. "We're promoting this arm in arm with them. A lot of our employees are represented by the Union, and some of them access United Way Winnipeg services, so it's important to them on a personal level, too."

The joint effort between Motor Coach and IAMAW-1953 made a huge difference in campaign activities like Bus Pull, where Union members and staff came together to demonstrate just what's possible when we pull together.

"And we always try to make it fun. 50/50s, bake sales – activities like that," said Sutton. "And everyone gets a pledge form."

Hard work and collaboration paid off, with four new Leaders and a total campaign increase of 35.2% – Motor Coach's most successful campaign year to date!

When President & CEO Jeff Goy stepped up in 2019 to serve as Campaign Chair, Wawanesa's employees stepped up too – putting their community values into action by working together and raising more than \$500,000 for United Way Winnipeg.

Wawanesa encouraged employees to think about their gift's potential and introduced a new Leadership challenge: to become a Wawanesa Community Driver by donating \$2,000 or more. Employees across Canada and the U.S. rose to this challenge. Wawanesa noted an increase of Leadership donors of \$1,200 or more from 109 in 2018, to 175 Leaders in 2019 – an increase of 60%! Of the 175 Leaders, 71 are at the Wawanesa Community Driver level.

Wawanesa also increased opportunities for employees to get involved and learn about United Way Winnipeg by adding engagement activities to their fundraising campaign.

This commitment to engagement resulted in more than 130 people visiting United Way Winnipeg donor-supported agency partners, more than 30 Day of Caring volunteer opportunities, and nearly 5,000 items donated through collection drives during their three-week campaign. More employees were able to see first-hand how big an impact their donations could have, and this motivated them to go above and beyond the call for support.

New Workplace Campaign ROBINSON

Ask any of ROBINSON's 140 Winnipeg employees, and they'll tell you that you don't need to run a long workplace campaign to have a big impact in the community.

Over five days, staff from ROBINSON's five Winnipeg locations (wholesale, retail and head office) organized many unique fundraisers for their workplace campaign, including bake sales, used book sales, and a scavenger hunt. Money raised in the community stays in the community. That was one of the driving themes behind Enns Brothers' United Way workplace campaign.

2019 was Enns Brothers' first year running a campaign with United Way Winnipeg. The locally owned John Deere dealership has nine locations throughout the province, with deep roots in each of their communities.

"Our employees are incredibly generous and actively involved their local communities," said Carolyn Kristjanson, Director of Human Resources. "Once they were able to see the breadth of services supported by the United Way in their community, they were completely on board."

Each branch had Campaign Captains, who distributed materials and drummed up energy and excitement.

"I was fully on board with the campaign because I know that all of our donations will help people in our communities," said Shirley Berard, Campaign Captain, Morris. The Campaign Captains also helped explain the campaign activities, like "One S'wheat contest," where customers and staff were encouraged to buy a number from the guess board and guess how many kernels of wheat were in a jar.

All employees who signed up for the payroll deduction giving option were entered in a draw to win a day off with pay.

"Plus, every dollar we contributed was matched by the company, and that was also a great incentive to participate," said Ron Graham, Campaign Captain, Oak Bluff.

In total, Enns Brothers raised just over \$26,000, far surpassing its campaign goal of \$16,000.

Enns Brothers is already planning ahead for next year and hopes to invite speakers from United Way Winnipeg's Speakers Bureau, to share their stories about the impact of donations to the agencies serving our communities.





Brain Architecture Game PAYWORKS

The Brain Architecture Game is United Way Winnipeg's latest offering for organizations wanting to engage their staff in a unique and impactful way.

For years, Payworks has been a big supporter of United Way Winnipeg activities as opportunities for staff to learn more about local issues and agencies at work in the community.

"We were looking for a way to engage staff, and the Brain Architecture Game had just come out," said Dee dela Cruz, Business Analyst. "We thought it was a good fit for our workplace."

United Way Winnipeg facilitates the Brain Architecture Game at workplaces to help develop an understanding of the effects of stress, particularly toxic stress, on the development of a child's brain and the lifelong impact on health and well-being.

Serving as a model for childhood experiences, the exercise brings participants together to

"build" a child's brain out of straws and pipe cleaners. Every time the hypothetical child experiences toxic stress in life, a support is taken away, or as the child gets older, a weight is added. Without proper supports in place, the foundation may not be strong enough to support it, and the structure could collapse.

Approximately 25 Payworks staff participated in the game, including dela Cruz and Trevor MacHutchon, CRM Manager.

"When you have support, you take it for granted," said MacHutchon. "It's monumental and devastating to someone who doesn't have that support. And when too many negative experiences outweigh the positive, it's hard to turn things around."

MacHutchon and dela Cruz said they found the game a great way to gain perspective and understand the importance of supporting childhood development and building strong communities.
